







- An Age-Friendly, competitive, mini-grant program was established for up to five (5) municipalities or organizations receiving mini-grants to implement agefriendly strategies related to age-friendly domains and urgent areas as identified in the age-friendly surveys conducted in 2017.
- This was an opportunity to:

- Baptist Health South Florida
 West Kendall Baptist Hospital
 - In an effort to improve quality of life for residents who have preventable hospital readmissions, West Kendall Baptist Hospital is launching a Promotores de Salud (PDS) initiative through Healthy West Kendall to bridge the gap between underserved community members and the resources necessary to live a healthy life. With the support for the mini-grant, the project will leverage partnerships in the community, including the faith-based community, to engage community health worker volunteers to support patients in need of additional assistance once they transition home. There will be a focus on transportation, nutritious meals, access, and social companionship.

North Bay Village

North Bay Village will install a small computer lab in the lobby of the Village Hall Building and incorporate a health and wellness campaign for older adults. The goals of this project are to (1) Increase social interaction among older adults residing in North Bay Village; (2) Increase participants' awareness of services that are available in the community. Village staff and volunteers instruct residents on how to pay bills on-line; navigate the Village and Miami-Dade County websites; access information concerning health management or free/low cost medications; or creating social media accounts to remain connected to loved ones.









Dade Heritage Trust

Dade Heritage Trust's mission is to preserve the Miami-Dade community's architectural, environmental and cultural heritage through education and advocacy. The mini-grant will benefit Dade Heritage Trust's project that will focus on building civic engagement in the West Grove. This will be accomplished through the building of a community garden and community programming in historic Bahamian-American wood frame homes. Programs will include garden cultivation, cooking, and baking classes in order to promote a healthy and nutritious lifestyle.







Youth Co-Op

Youth Co-Op is a private non-profit whose mission is to promote the social well-being of individuals in South Florida through education, employment, and empowerment. In partnership with the Miami-Dade Age-Friendly Initiative, Youth Co-Op will be setting up a computer training lab for older adults to use in searching for employment as well as to use for training for learning new technology, and upgrading and/or learning new skills in Microsoft Office. This project offers older adults opportunities to increase their success in reaching financial stability.








- Florida International University
 Nicole Wertheim College of Nursing & Health Sciences
 - This collaborative project between FIU's Physical Therapy, Interior and Landscape Architecture, Environmental and Urban Design, and Computer Science departments will redesign Miami's Underline Park under the Metrorail to be more "agefriendly". Virtual and augmented-reality will be used to reimage and reconstruct the space based on input from older adults living in the community. Functional (mobility-related), behavioral and environmental attributes such as physical/visual accessibility and psychophysiological facilitators such as relaxation and motivation will be assessed. Evidence-based solutions for active aging will be provided to redesign the space to match older adults' preferences and capabilities to effect active lifestyles.


