GOAL: The goal of IMPACT is to improve depression treatment by providing collaborative care to older adults.

Patient and Physician Reminders to Promote Colorectal Cancer Screening (Massachusetts)

Filed under Evidence-Based Practice, Health / Cancer, Adults, Elderly

GOAL: The goal of this program is to increase colorectal cancer screening rates among older primary care patients.

School-Based Asthma Therapy (Rochester, NY)

Filed under Evidence-Based Practice, Health / Respiratory Diseases, Children, Families, Urban

GOAL: The objective of this study was to examine the health benefits and cost-effectiveness of the School-Based Asthma Therapy (SBAT) program compared with usual care.

IMPACT: School-Based Asthma Therapy resulted in 158 symptom-free days per month per 100 children and a costeffectiveness of \$10 per symptom-free day.

Chicago Housing Health Partnership (Cook)

60AL: The goal of the Chicago Housing Health Partnership is to use tailored case management to place chronically medically ill homeless individuals in stable, long-term housing and facilitate access to medical services.

While most people are familiar with Homeland Security's charge of battling terrorism, the department does much more. It also deals with handling domestic emergencies and natural disasters such as hurricanes and earthquakes. They also deal with any type of terrorism, including man-made events such as the Boston Marathon bombing. While some of these cases fall solely within the purview of Homeland Security, others, such as responding to national disasters, have the department working along with the National Guard and other agencies. Homeland Security is broken down into a number of agencies, each of which has a particular charge. These include border protection, customs enforcement, transportation security, the coast guard, the secret service, and FEMA.






